



HOW TO FIND US

From Thirsk: Continue on A170 and turn left at mini roundabout onto Stepney Drive. After 1/2 mile turn left onto A171 (Scalby Road) for 200 yards. Turn left again at traffic lights into Woodlands Drive. Pass the hospital on right hand side and continue for 400 yards more then turn right into Graham School. The Table Tennis Centre is 100 yards on your left.

From York: Continue on A64 until 3rd set of traffic light. Turn left onto A171 (Falsgrave Road) for 200 yards then at mini roundabout turn right onto Scalby Road (A171). After 1/4 mile continue straight over roundabout. After 1/2 mile turn left again at traffic lights into Woodlands Drive. Pass the hospital on right hand side and continue for 400 yards more then turn right into Graham School. The Table Tennis Centre is 100 yards on your left.

From Bridlington: Continue on A165 straight through first 2 sets of traffic lights. Turn left at third traffic lights (railway station) onto Falsgrave Road (A64). Continue through 2 sets of traffic lights and after a further 200 yards turn right at mini roundabout onto Scalby Road (A171). After 1/4 mile continue straight over roundabout. After 1/2 mile turn left again at traffic lights into Woodlands Drive. Pass the hospital on right hand side and continue for 400 yards more then turn right into Graham School

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entry Form – Further entry forms are available from Amanda Lee or Scarborough Table Tennis centre and should be returned to Amanda Lee, 45 Newlands Park Drive, Scarborough. YO12 6DW by no later than 23rd August 2010 Entry forms can also be obtained from the YTТА website www.ytta.co.uk or Scarborough Table Tennis Club website Please make cheques payable to: SCARBOROUGH TABLE TENNIS CLUB
2. Junior players are only allowed to enter two age groups, their own and 1 higher. The cost of entering the junior events is £8 per player regardless of how many events are entered.
Senior players may enter up to 4 events (age permitting) and the cost will be £15 per player. Only two singles events can be entered
The Open Singles are open to both Men and Lady Players; the Open Doubles can be any combination (2 Men, 2 Ladies or Mixed)
3. Entries – If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on a basis of last received first out.
4. Draw – The draw will take place at 7pm Friday 27th August 2010 at the Scarborough Table Tennis Centre
5. Playing conditions – Play throughout will be on 8 Butterfly tables with Butterfly nets and posts. Double Happiness 3 star balls will be used.
6. Practice – There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
7. Car parking – Car Parking (at owners' risk) is available at venue.
8. Refreshments – Light refreshments will be on sale.
9. Prizes will be awarded to all Winners and Runners Up on the day
10. Notification – Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match by email if an email has address been given or by post providing a stamped addressed envelope has been sent with the entry form.
11. Vintage Singles Players must have been born on or before 01.01.1961
Veteran Singles Players must have been born on or before 01.01.1971
Junior Events Players must have been born on or after 01.01.1993
Cadet Events Players must have been born on or after 01.01.1996
U13 Events Players must have been born on or after 01.01.1998
U11 Events Players must have been born on or after 01.01.2000

ETTA APPROVED LAWS OF THE GAME WILL APPLY

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. Every entrant must be affiliated to the YTТА through a club/league in either North or East Yorkshire
2. ETTA Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament including Regulation R (Racket Re-Rubbering). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
4. All competitors will be required to umpire group matches and losing players in the knockout matches should remain at the table to umpire the following match.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which will be on a group basis, numbers permitting.
6. Competitors must wear rubber-soled shoes and clothing which complies with ETTA Tournament regulation 29. ITTF Clothing Regulation 3.2.2.9. Will not apply (x).
7. Any member taking part in gambling, other than participation in any lottery or similar competition conducted by or with the permission of the organising committee, shall be liable to immediate disqualification from the Tournament and expulsion from the premises, either of which shall be reported to the ETTA.
8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
9. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
10. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
11. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up within the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
12. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final
